

Request for Reynolds Tuition Assistance Grant

- J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College provides tuition assistance funds to students to address issues of access and completion. In order to be considered for these funds, students must meet the following preliminary criteria:
 - Have a completed and current Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on record;
 - Demonstrate need for assistance;
 - Be in good academic standing at the College;
 - Be in a curricular program;
 - Courses taken must be required for the student's program of study noted on the Reynold Tuition Assistance Grant Form (No. 30-0004);
 - Receipt of these funds cannot result in the generation of a refund to the student due to overpayment;
 - Meet certain criteria such as GPA or other requirements for the specific fund being requested; and
 - Submit a written request a completed Form No. 30-

No more than 12 credits per semester will be awarded. Awards are
automatically renewed through the completion of the remaining 18 credits (or
less) of the degree program or remaining 12 credits (or less) of the
certificate/career studies certificate program for which he/she has applied for
under the grant, if the student meets preliminary criteria and complete
